TERMS AND CONDITIONS FOR USE OF THE WEBSITE SCOTEID.COM AND THE SCOTEID.COM DATABASE KEEPERS OF SHEEP

ScotEID.com Limited, a company limited by guarantee and registered in Scotland, having company number SC382963 and having its registered office at Rural Centre, Ingliston, Edinburgh, EH28 8MZ (hereinafter called "ScotEID")

INTRODUCTION

These terms and conditions apply to (i) the entire contents of the website under the domain name "Scoteid.com" ("Website"); and (ii) the entire contents of the ScotEID database which is to be found via the Website whether in electronic or hard copy form or otherwise ("Database"). Using the Website and / or the Database indicates that you accept these terms regardless of whether or not you choose to register with the Website. If you do not accept these terms, do not use the Website or the Database.

ScotEID may revise these terms and conditions at any time by updating this posting. You should check the Website from time to time to review the then current terms and conditions, because they are binding on you.

DEFINITIONS AND INTERPRETATION

1.1 In these terms and conditions the following definitions shall apply unless the context requires otherwise:-

"Critical Control Points" means as defined in the Order;

"Order" means The Sheep and Goats (Records, Identification and Movement) (Scotland) Order 2009 as amended from time to time;

"Tag(s)" means an electronic tag affixed to sheep in accordance with the Order; "writing" includes facsimile transmission, e-mail or comparable means of communication.

- 1.2 Any reference in these terms and conditions to any statute or provision of a statute shall be construed as a reference to that statute or provision as amended, re-enacted or extended at the relevant time.
- 1.3 The headings in these terms and conditions are for convenience only and shall not affect their interpretation.
- 1.4 Unless the context otherwise requires, references in these terms and conditions to "person" includes any individual, company, corporation, firm, partnership, joint venture, association, organisation, institution, trust or agency, whether or not having a separate legal personality.
- 1.5. The rights and protections of ScotEID under these terms and conditions may be exercised and claimed by Scottish Agricultural Organisation Society Limited ("SAOS"), which is continuing research in connection with the traceability of sheep in Scotland.

2. REGISTRATION

- 2.1 You may access some areas of the Website without registering your details on the Website. You may only access the Database online if you register your details on the Website.
- 2.2 You can register your details on the Website by completing the registration form ("Registration") at [http://www.scoteid.com/index.php?q=user/register] You may gain assistance with registration by telephone to the ScotEID information centre on 01466 794323. Each registration is for a single user only. ScotEID does not permit you to share your user name and password with any person nor with multiple users on a network.
- 2.3 You undertake that all the details you provide to ScotEID on the Registration are true, complete and accurate.

- 2.4 By submitting your Registration you are responsible for maintaining the confidentiality of your password for the Website. Please inform ScotEID immediately if your password is disclosed to a third party. ScotEID shall have no liability for any activities that occur on your account or for any data that is inputted into your account in any circumstances.
- 2.5 By submitting your Registration you acknowledge that the Website and the Database will be used for the identification and traceability of sheep in Scotland and for continuing research purposes. As such, you agree to provide ScotEID with such information as it may reasonably require from time to time in relation to this subject matter.
- 2.6 By submitting your Registration you agree to give feedback to ScotEID on the Website and/or Database on ScotEID's reasonable request and you accept that you may be contacted by ScotEID and/or SAOS for research purposes.

2.8 Registration

By submitting your Registration you:

- 2.8.1 Agree to SAOS using the movement data received from animals electronically tagged and from the data submitted to the Website for research purposes.
- 2.8.2. Agree to co-operate and assist at Critical Control Points and, if necessary, to resubmit your sheep for electronic reading if any of the equipment at such Critical Control Points fails or the accuracy of their readings would benefit from re-testing;
- 2.8.3. You acknowledge that the accuracy of the information contained on the Database must be checked by You. Neither ScotEID nor the Critical Control Point shall have any responsibility in respect thereof;
- 2.8.4 Agree to regularly maintain all the movements and other records of your flock on the Database on the Website and that all the information you submit to the Website shall be true and accurate. If it comes to your attention that you have provided the Website with erroneous reports you agree to notify ScotEID of the error as soon as reasonably practicable;

3. PROVISION OF WEBSITE AND DATABASE

- 3.1 The Website and Database is continually innovating. You acknowledge and agree that the form and nature of the Website and Database which ScotEID provides may change from time to time without prior notice. You also acknowledge and agree that ScotEID may temporarily stop providing use of some or all of the Website and/ or the Database without prior notice.

You waive any moral rights therein and any other rights to be acknowledged as the author.
- 4.3 You accept that you shall not obtain any intellectual property rights in relation to any of the information or data contained on the Website (save in relation to any information or data submitted by you).

You personal data may be given to any relevant government department or agency and any other individual or organisation which has a bona fide interest in sheep identification has a bona fide interest or agency and any other individual or organisation which has a bona fide interest in sheep identification and traceability in Scotland. It is accepted that such report may be made public. Your personal data may be given to any relevant government department or agency and any other individual or organisation which has a bona fide interest in sheep identification and traceability in Scotland for these purposes but will not be disclosed by ScotEID to any other organisation for any other purpose other than in relation to cases of suspected fraud.
- 4.5. You are prohibited from posting or transmitting to or from the Website and/ or the Database any material:
