2	Please affix you barcode sticker. As well as providing your main CPH, we scan the
	barcode when processing the form.
3	If you have an existing ScotEID username, that you wish to use for ScotMoves, we will use this for your ScotMoves registration. This will be the username you use to login to ScotEID.
4	We can create a ScotEID account for you. Your 'username' should be one word,
	fairly short and easy for you to remember. We also require an email address that
	you have access to. We will inform you of your password by post, which you can
_	change afterwards at any time.
5	This must be in the format CC/PPP/HHHH.
6	When using additional holdings, you must keep your cattle separate from the
	livestock of other keepers who are occupying the same holding.
	To prevent standstill rules taking effect when livestock move on and off your

	not trigger a standstill for your livestock.
